Characteristics

circus-related skills development, familiarization with circus props, forms of movement, basic techniques

19 counties, 45 cultural territories, 45 small towns (below 5000 inhabitants)

repetitive, regular development; learning and practicing how to use circus props (3 occasions)

for example, juggling, equilibria, human tower, juggling with plates, etc.

2 colleagues - 1 circus educator (theory) and 1 circus skills developer (practice)

classes of 90-120 minutes

small, homogene group of 30 people

accredited 30 hour-long continuing education based on the program organized by Budapest Circus Arts and Contemporary Dance College

Achievements

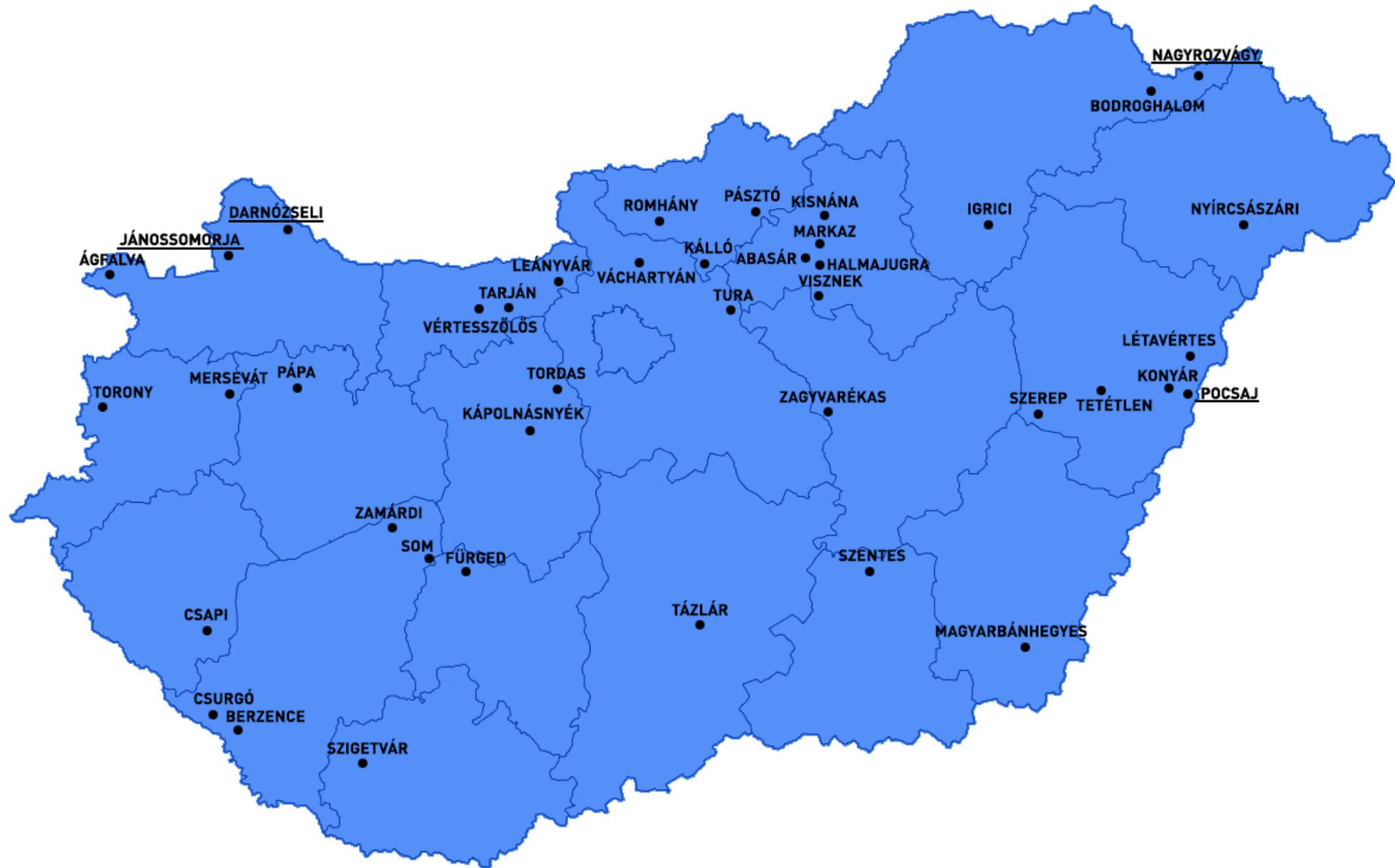
4050 children aided
